Finance:

- Endowment interest being put into separate savings account
- Special project budgets listed as restricted subtracted from cash available
- Cash on hand \$98,093.33
- Motion to approve treasurers report: Katy, 2nd Bill approved

Budget:

- Additions will be listed in forecast vs. budget
- Membership on track only \$130 behind April 2023

Events:

- Dressage Show
 - o 29 riders, 51 tests Mostly locals
 - o Revenue over \$1000 for first show
 - 2 more shows scheduled in July and August
- Pet Run
 - Net around \$900-1,000
 - o 63 entries roughly similar 2022
 - Plan for annual event strategies to grow without increasing expenses drastically
- 4H Camp
 - o 9 kids overnighted all went well, smaller group this year
- Pony Club H/J
 - Great event, over 80 entries and roughly 45 stalls filled

Project Updates

Water complex is 85% complete – Zane plans to finish construction this week so we can open it
a week before the Derby, XC course revamp will be done in conjunction with the completion of
the water complex

Finance

- Event coordinator packets instructions for event coordinators

BSSC

- Submitted a request for reimbursement for a project that didn't pass any reimbursement requests need to be capital improvements that benefit the entire Big Sky Park complex
- How to submit requests for capital improvement projects –
- Future of the park only the 5 acres of the 4H area and the Community Gardens are protected
 - Promote more community involvement, relationship with community, BSSC, County

Maintenance

Need to get shavings from Bitterroot – 15 pallets to transport to the park

Cirque

- Cirque returning first weekend of July, charging \$3,000 facility rental
 - Parking does a BSHP group or partner want to take on parking arrangements for donations?

Merchandise

- Using Venmo or other online payment
 - Want to purchase a tablet for park use starting with merchandise, eventually using events
 - \$300 request to purchase a tablet, \$120/year to have hotspot/wifi
 - Motion to approve the \$300 to purchase a tablet with the provision that Clara work with Jennifer to set up payment, with the provision that the tablet be kept at Jennifer's office: Jennifer, 2nd Natalie – approved

Kubota

- Kubota currently has 0% down 0% interest for 60 months, plus a discount for the Horse Council
- Would also need a bigger rake attachment could add that through Kubota
- John Deere prices came back roughly 20% higher current tractor is Kubota and would be good to stick with the same brand
- Jennifer recommends to make a report of the tractor purchase to send to the entire board
